

RESOLUTION #2951

**AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK REMOVALS AT
ADAMS, OLSEN AND GREINER TOWERS
TO PRESTIGE ENVIRONMENTAL INNOVATION FOR \$16,000**

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the Township of Woodbridge (Authority) has a need to remove three underground storage tanks and replace two with above ground tanks; and;

WHEREAS, this contract is to be awarded through a “fair and open process” pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority created proposal documents and specifications dated 8/28/18; and

WHEREAS, following timely advertisement for bids in the Home News Tribune on 8/4/18, for same, the following proposals were received:

Prestige Environmental Innovation Plainfield, NJ	\$16,000.00	Various for potential contamination remediation
AWT Environmental Services, Inc. Sayreville, NJ	\$46,315.00	No additional fees were listed

WHEREAS, upon review of the proposals, it was determined that the most advantageous proposal was submitted by Prestige Environmental Innovation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the Township of Woodbridge that the Contract Officer of the Authority, Donna F. Brightman be, and is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver on behalf of the Authority a contract for the Underground Storage Tank Removals as specified in the Request for Proposal documents to Prestige Environmental Innovation in the amount of \$16,000.00.
