**RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A PUBLIC AGENCY COMPLIANCE OFFICER (P.A.C.O.)**

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.2 et. Seq., each public agency shall annually designate an officer or employee to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer (P.A.C.O.); and

**WHEREAS**, the individual designated as the Public Agency Compliance Officer will be the point of contact for all matters concerning implementation and administration of the legal requirements of the Equal Employment Opportunity Monitoring Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Agency Compliance Officer is also responsible for administering contracting procedures pertaining to equal employment regarding both the public agency and its service providers; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.3, each public agency shall notify the State of New Jersey, Department of the Treasury, Division of Purchases & Property, Contract Compliance Audit Unit, EEO Monitoring Program of its designation by January 10<sup>th</sup> of each year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Housing Authority of the Township of Woodbridge wishes to designate Lawrence Stecker, Director of Maintenance and Modernization to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer for the calendar year 2020.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the Township of Woodbridge, New Jersey that Lawrence Stecker is hereby designated to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer for the calendar year 2020.
