

## RESOLUTION #3075

### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COVID-19 STIPEND

**WHEREAS**, as on March 21, 2020 Governor Murphy signed Executive Order 107 which diverted all non-essential workers to stay-at-home to avoid the spread of COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, the staff of the Woodbridge Housing Authority continued to work to provide services to its tenants including weekends; and

**WHEREAS**, these services included wellness checks, isolation counseling, delivery of dropped-off items by family members, food delivery and sanitizing common areas; and

**WHEREAS**, staff members were not compensated for weekend hours and agreed to a lump sum overtime stipend; and

**WHEREAS**, the stipend rate is \$3,000 for maintenance staff and \$2,000 for office staff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the Township of Woodbridge, hereby authorizes the Executive Director to distribute the COVID-19 stipends of \$3,000 for maintenance staff and \$2,000 for office staff from the CARES funding distributed to the Authority from HUD.
