

RESOLUTION #3249

AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE BOILER REPLACEMENT AT GREINER TOWERS TO SILVA'S MECHANICAL SERVICES FOR \$55,880

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the Township of Woodbridge (Authority) has a need to replace the generator at Greiner Towers; and

WHEREAS, this contract shall be awarded through a fair and open process pursuant to 19:44A-20.4 et. seq., and

WHEREAS, the Authority created bid documents and specifications dated 4/27/23; and

WHEREAS, following timely advertisement for sealed bids in the Home News Tribune on 4/2/23 and 4/3/23, for same, the following bids were opened and read before the public:

Kelin Heating & Air Conditioning, Inc. Colonia, NJ	\$59,993.16
Whitfield Schneider Enterprises, Inc. W. Long Branch, NJ	\$68,350.00
K&D Contracting, LLC Kenilworth, NJ	\$120,500.00

WHEREAS, upon review of all bids, it was determined that the lowest responsive and responsible bidder was Silva's Mechanical Services for the boiler replacement at Greiner Towers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the Township of Woodbridge that the Contract Officer of the Authority, Donna F. Brightman be, and is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver on behalf of the Authority a contract for the boiler replacement at Greiner Towers as specified in the contract documents to Silva's Mechanical Services in the amount not to exceed \$55,800.00.
